A MESSAGE FROM THE COMMISSIONER



We know there is no one single alcohol and drug abuse problem that exists. The problems are multifaceted. Different people experience different problems at different times for different reasons. No one single prevention or treatment approach will work with everyone.

Therefore, we are committed to having at least the bare minimum in Kansas, which is a complete continuum of care across the state.

But, as we work toward that goal, we see a need to constantly bring people and resources together. This Directory is an attempt to provide a Resource Book for "people to turn to."

In every state, there's an alcohol and drug abuse state agency that sets the framework and forsees the long-range needs of the state. In Kansas, that administrative agency is the Kansas Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services/Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services.

SRS/Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services is designated to plan, coordinate, fund, monitor, license and certify alcohol and/or drug abuse programs.

The agency provides funding and technical assistance to local communities and programs in the development and implementation of alcohol and drug prevention and treatment programs.

The overall goals are to:

1. Insure that effective treatment services are provided to individuals and families experiencing alcohol and/or other drug problems.
2. Insure effective prevention services are provided to the general public and target poulations to prevent the development of alcohol and/or other drug problems, and
3. To train alcohol and drug personnel to improve the effectiveness of services provided to people in Kansas

For the people of Kansas, an Alcohol and Drug Clearinghouse is maintained. At no cost, brochures and films are available upon request.

Two newsletters, the Kansas Alcohol and Drug News and the Prevention Information Exchange are published quarterly.

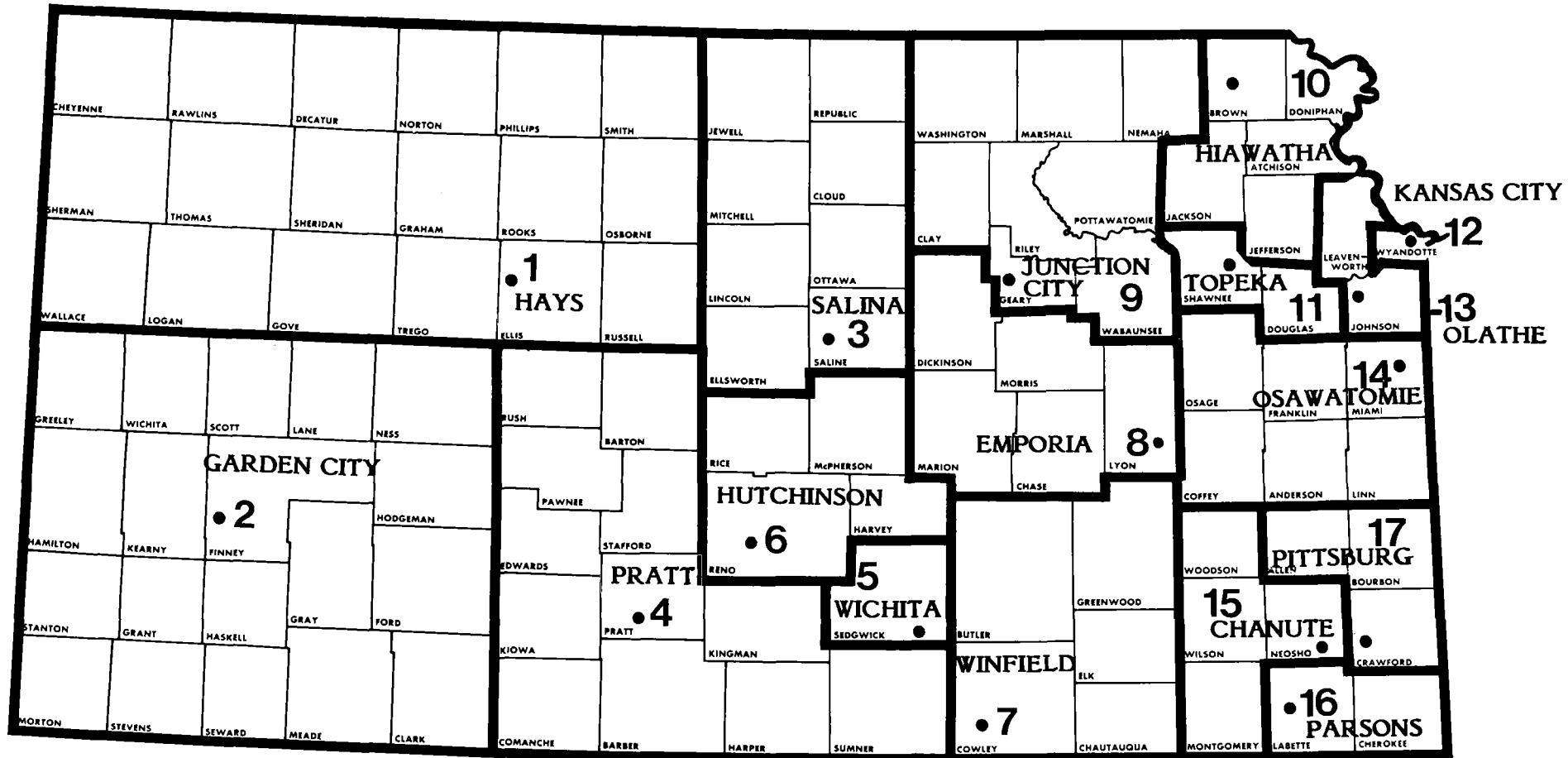
