If you want to request a birth certificate for someone else, fill out the 'Requesting Party' field with your relationship to the person whose birth certificate you are requesting (e.g., spouse, parent, child, grandchild, or grandparent). However, when receiving a birth certificate, there are stricter requirements. You can only receive it if you are listed in the "Requesting Party" field as an authorized representative of the applicant or document owner. If you need an authorization letter for the process, the following documents must be presented: - A signed and original valid ID of the document owner, spouse, grandparent, child, or grandchild - An original valid ID of the authorized representative - An authorization letter from the document owner, their spouse, or direct descendants (as indicated in the "Requesting Party" field) If you are unable to receive your PSA documents personally, your representative must have an authorization letter that allows them to sign for your documents and make decisions on your behalf. Authorization letters allow a designated representative to act on behalf of an individual for various tasks, such as using their motorcycle, claiming money from banks or organizations, withdrawing funds from accounts, enrolling in school, requesting transcripts, claiming packages, and more. The type of authorization required can vary based on the specific task and institution involved. For instance, depending on your Rest Day Off (RDO), you might need either an authorization letter or a Special Power of Attorney. These letters are essential for situations where you cannot be present yourself but still need certain actions taken on your behalf. They serve as proof that you have given your consent and approval to the representative to act in your stead. In cases involving minors or individuals who are not mentally capable, guardians may also need to approve medical treatments or other decisions. For family members, authorization can be granted for tasks like caring for a minor child during trips where the parent cannot join. When creating an authorization letter, it's crucial that the person given authority is trustworthy and reliable. The document should accurately reflect the scope of responsibilities you are delegating, ensuring clarity for all parties involved.
